



Margulies Perruzzi To Design for Boston Home Base Program

Margulies Perruzzi Architects of Boston has been selected to provide design services for the new Home Base Program at Massachusetts General Hospital, which is aimed at helping veterans of Afghanistan and Iraq affected by post-traumatic stress disorder and traumatic brain injury. Margulies Perruzzi will design 4,000 square feet of space for the new program and related departments. The new space, which includes related clinical, family support, research, and education programs, is slated to open this summer. The Home Base Program is a partnership between the Red Sox Foundation and Massachusetts General Hospital, in cooperation with the Department of Veterans Affairs.
